Their research has involved data from approximately 10,000 youth regarding their experiences with cyber-bullying offending and victimization. They are currently partnering with administrators and teachers at a number of different school districts to explore the nature of traditional and **online victimization**. They also provide training to educators, counselors, law enforcement, parents, and youth on how to prevent and address the school-based consequences of cyber-bullying.
